After Activity

Kids Keep	Their cardboard shield
You Keep	Paper wads and markers (save to
	reuse)

To Do

Say: Let's pretend these are your shields to help you join Jesus in fighting evil! What good things did He make you good at to help this world be good and new? Draw a few things you're really good at on your shield!

- 1. Give each kid a cardboard circle and a place markers where kids can access them.
- 2. Kids write or draw their ideas on their shields. As kids work, **read** ideas from the All Things New activity supplement printed on back to help.
- 3. Crumple the sheets of paper into wads (if not already

Say: Okay, let's test those shields! Stop coloring, and hold them up to see how you can fight alongside Jesus!

- 4. **Read** an idea from the activity supplement, then toss paper wads at the shields.
- 5. As time allows, repeat step 4, reading a new situation for each round

Choose a Question to Get Your Group Talking

- What are some unfair or wrong things that upset you?
- What are some good things you can do to help Jesus make all things new?
- When something isn't fair or right, what gives you hope inside your heart?

Wrap Up

- Pray together.
- Do the small group activity again or play a game like Charades or Duck, Duck, Goose.

Leader Tip

Be consistent in how you treat kids in your group. If you over-reward one kid or over-reprimand another, they might think you have favorites. This can erode their trust.

Ways to make all things new:

Use these ideas for both drawing/writing on the shields and playing the game.

- When people leave trash on the ground, I can pick it up.
- When someone is sad, I can draw a beautiful picture to make them smile.
- When someone feels left out, I can show kindness to them.
- When someone feels like no one cares about them, I can give them a gift.
- When someone is sick, I can pray for them.
- When a pet needs food, water, or love, I can take care of them.
- When a little kid throws a fit, I can be gentle with them.
- When my friends want to do something wrong, I can stand up for what's right.
- When I want to argue, instead I can choose to listen and talk respectfully.
- When someone doesn't know Jesus loves them, I can tell them how to be His friend.
- When people are hungry, I can share some food with them.
- If I disagree with someone, I can still choose to be kind and loving to them.
- When someone is sad, I can say an encouraging Bible verse to them.

- When I want to complain about schoolwork, I can write a thankyou note to my teacher instead.
- When a bully is picking on me or someone else, I can tell them to stop, and tell a trusted adult.
- If someone seems upset, I can ask them if they'd like to talk about it.
- When someone feels lonely, I can spend time with them.
- If I see something scary, confusing, or weird, I can tell a trusted adult.
- When I see a huge mess, I can help clean it up.
- When someone seems worried or stressed out, I can ask what I can do to help.
- When someone gets hurt, I can tell a trusted adult. I can even get them a Band-Aid!
- When people are fighting, I can try to help them work it out and get help from a trusted adult.
- When something seems unfair, I can speak up with respectful words.
- When someone is crying a lot, I can sit with them quietly.
- When someone needs to relax, I can help them take deep breaths and be still.

Per Group	Nothing

After Activity

Kids Keep	Their invisible ink pen and paper
You Keep	Nothing

To Do

Say: These pens leave messages that can't be seen unless you shine a special light on them. Draw some bright, shiny things about Jesus with your pen: like loving things Jesus wants to say to us, things that are awesome about Jesus, or something great Jesus teaches us.

- 1. Give each kid a paper and one of the special pens.
- Kids draw or write things about Jesus on their paper with the invisible ink. Read the Jesus Is the Light activity supplement (printed on back) out loud while kids work to give them ideas.
- Kids shine their pen's UV light on what they drew or wrote to reveal it to the group. Note: Have kids show you what they wrote first to make sure it's appropriate.

Say: Keep your special pen to remind you that Jesus is the light of the world. When things feel dark or confusing, Jesus is like a super bright flashlight to show us God's love and God's good way.

4. **As time allows**, kids **continue to decorate** their paper with their invisible ink pens.

What do you think this Bible Verse is talking about?

Change a Question to Cot Your Crown Talking.

Choose a Question to Get Your Group Talking • How do you think Jesus can give light to a kid when

- they feel lost or confused inside?
- Learning from Jesus helps His light grow in you. What are some ways you can learn from Jesus?
- Name some trusted people who can help you when you feel confused, lost, or like you're in the dark.

Wrap Up

- Pray together.
- **Do** the small group activity again or **play** a game like *Thumb Wars* or *Telephone*.

Leader Tip

Remember, kids trust leadership that's clear and consistent. It gives them comfort and security to know what's okay and what's not.

To Do

Say: Wow. I've got some tough challenges for you—let's see how well you do. I'll watch but I won't help out!

- Assign kids a challenge from the activity supplement printed on the back of this guide.
- Kids do challenge for about 30 seconds while you stand still, arms crossed, without smiling. No helping!
- 3. When time's up, ask kids:
 - How hard was that challenge?
 - How did it feel when I didn't help or encourage you?
- Kids do the same challenge you picked the first time for about 30 seconds, but this time you smile, help, and say encouraging words from the back of this guide.
- 5. When time's up, **ask** kids:
 - How hard was the challenge this time?
 - How did it feel different doing the challenge when I helped you, encouraged you, and cheered you on?
- 6. As time allows, try new challenges, but use encouraging words like Jesus says from here on out!

- What do you think you can do to help someone who is suffering?

CHALLENGES

If a kid in your group has a disability that makes the active challenges impossible, choose non-active challenges.

Active

- Stand with arms out to sides while balancing on one foot.
- Sit down and stand up repeatedly.
- Run in place, while trying to touch your knees to your chest with each step.
- Plank.

Encouraging Words

Repeat phrases as necessary to fill the time.

- You can do this!
- I'm really proud of you!
- Wow! You're doing so well!
- You've got this!
- Keep it up!
- Don't quit!
- You're gonna make it!
- Keep breathing!
- Keep trying!
- Get after it! Come on!
- You're so close to finishing!
- Finish strong!

Non-Active

- Keep your eyes open without blinking.
- Hold your biggest smile on your face without lowering your cheeks once.
- Stick your tongue out as far as it can go, then back in your mouth as fast as possible.
- Say the alphabet backwards over and over.
